- Vendors must remove all items from stall(s) when leaving the fairgrounds at the end of the swap meet.

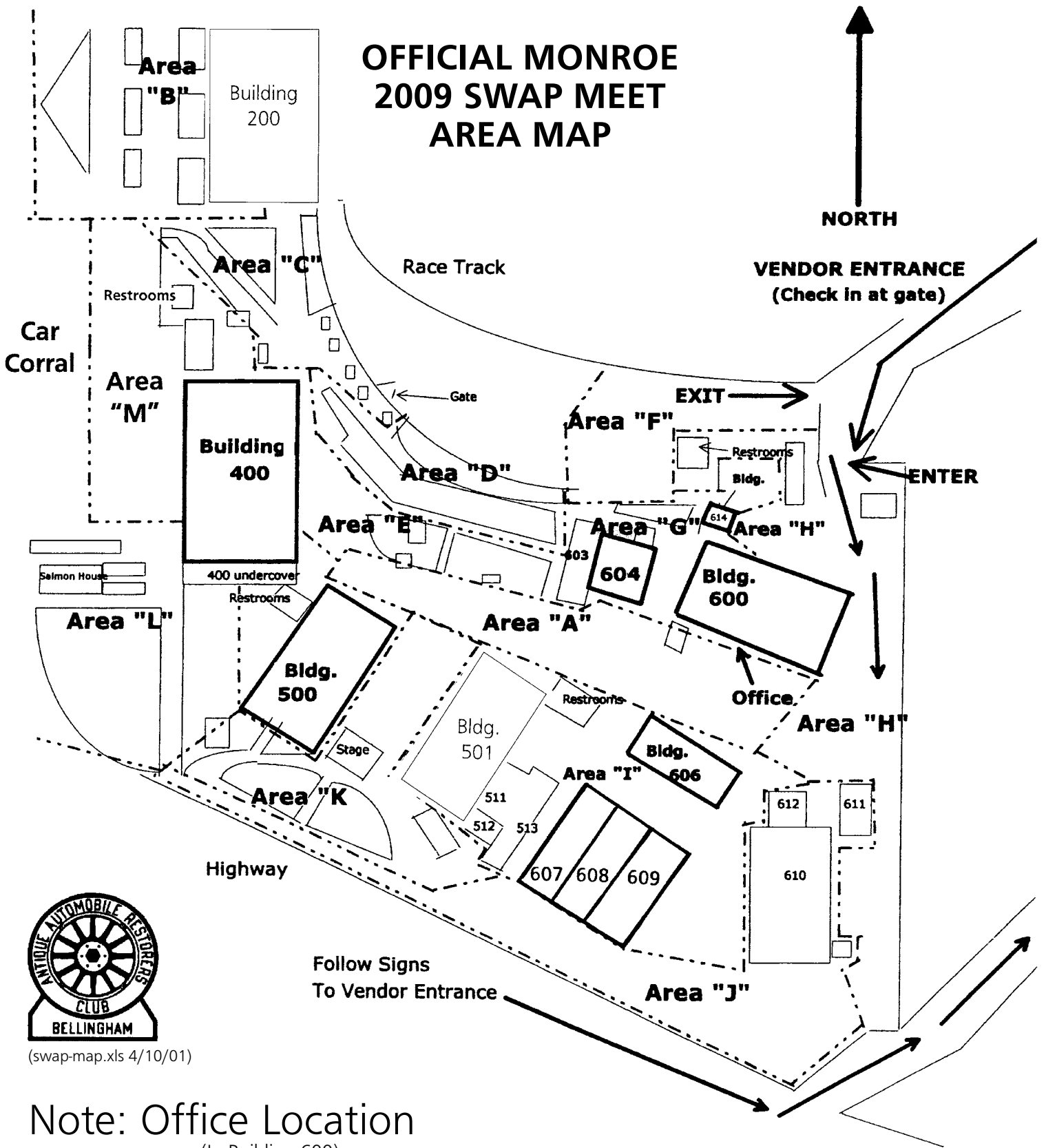
